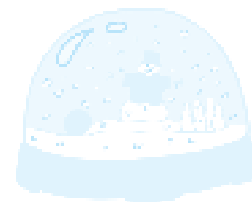

More Information about Kits & Supply Lists

Optional fabric kits are available for purchase on the day of class for Levels 1-5 for \$10.-15. each. These are payable to the instructor so please bring a check or exact change. Or you are welcome to bring your own supplies. Please be sure to pick up the supply list for each class before class time and have your fabrics cut and ready to go. There is no time in class to cut your fabric. Bring your machine, all accessories and books, thread, scissors, pen, paper and basic sewing supplies to all classes. Registration is necessary.

We're excited to offer you an expanded level of training for your Bernina sewing machine. These classes are available for all new and current machine purchases. Beginning Levels 1, 2, 3 and 7 (13 hours of instruction) are free of charge when purchased at Sneed's. Advanced Levels 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 10 are only \$10. per each 3 hour class. A CD of the 198 page workbook for all 6 levels is available at no charge. You will need to print this out before class as we use this as our class instructions. Please take care of this before class and bring your workbook with you. You will need to provide a 3 ring binder and page protectors. Be sure to also bring your instruction manual that came with your machine to all classes.

Level 1 must be taken before proceeding to the other levels, then you can mix levels as you wish. Optional fabric kits are available for Levels 1-5. See details at the page bottom. A supply list is available for all Levels but MM6 and MM 7. Just bring supplies listed with class below. Please stop by before class and pick up this information. Bring your machine, all accessories and books, thread, scissors, pen, paper and basic sewing supplies to all classes. **Registration is necessary.**

All classes are taught by Bernina Certified and trained instructors. Remember, not all sewing machine training is the same. Our strength is our educational program. We encourage you to take any and all of them as many times as you need. Fees apply each time you repeat a class. If your Bernina was purchased elsewhere, we will be happy to train you on your Bernina. Our price is \$25. per hour.

My Label+ classes are designed around using My Label OR a purchased pattern to create garments for you. My Label is Bernina's software that makes you your own personal fashion designer, with patterns pre-fit to your measurements. Many pattern companies give guidance printed on the patterns for alterations based on your measurements. These classes will focus on fitting and sewing garments and embellishing them—be they from either source. (Disclaimer – you do not need My Label to attend these classes)

Most of our sewing equipment has electronic parts. Electrostatic discharge is a real issue we need to be aware of. Even static electricity from your hairbrush is enough to short out a computer board. The first few pages of our instruction books tell us to unplug the machines from the wall when not in use. Our technical department has anti-static table mats that are grounded. Our technicians must wear a grounded wrist band when working on the machines. A blown electronic part is not covered under warranty. So protect your precious Bernina and invest in a good quality surge protector.

Keep adhesive spray away from your sewing or embroidery machine. While we love this product, it does great damage to our machines if the overspray lands on any parts. It dries like hair spray on hard surfaces. Spray your embroidery projects in a cardboard box.

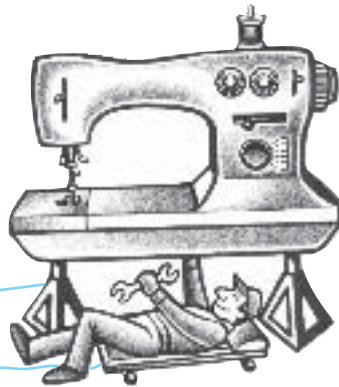

Class Policies

DISCLAIMER:

We have made every effort to ensure that the information contained within this newsletter is accurate and have presented it in good faith. However, due to human error or printing oversight we are unable to guarantee the final product.

Know Your Machine...

Please be proficient in the use of your particular sewing machine and be sure it is in good working order. We only require our instructors to be proficient in the Bernina product line. They may NOT be knowledgeable about other brands and may not be able to assist you with machine problems you may encounter during class time. For this reason, if you have a technical problem, we may ask you to switch over to one of our classroom machines. We offer an Obedience Class to help you become familiar with your machine. Just ask us for details.

Anyone with any brand of sewing machine is welcome to our classes. You may bring your own or borrow one of our Bernina sewing machines. If you are a Bernina owner, we ask that you bring your own machine since classroom machines are limited and we cannot guarantee you would receive the same model you own.

Registration and Payment:

We accept class sign-ups as soon as the newsletter is mailed and you receive it. If there is a special class you want, you may consider registering before the Teacher Open House as some classes fill that day. At the time of registration 1/2 of the class fee is due with the remainder due at the first class. You may register and pay:

1. In person at the store
2. By mail with a check (please include a note with details of class)
3. By phone with a credit card

Cancellation:

1. If we need to cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment, we give 7 days (one week) notice. You can decide how you would like the refund by choosing:
 - a. A full cash refund.
 - b. Or if you don't want a cash refund, you can transfer the class fee to another class during the same session.
 - c. Or you can ask for Bernina Bucks to be used later in the store towards classes or merchandise.
 - d. We do not give class credits to be used at a later undetermined date due to the amount of paperwork involved.
2. If you must cancel, we need 7 days (one week) notice to receive a refund less a \$5 processing fee per class. We have implemented the processing fee due to the high volume of paperwork involved.
3. Please be aware of the \$5 processing fee per class for class cancellation.
4. No refunds will be given after the class begins. No Show - No Refund.
5. Guest instructors command a "No Cancellation, No Refund, No Discount" policy and class must be paid in full.
6. If a class fills extremely fast, we sometimes offer a waiting list. Please ask if you're interested.

Supply Lists:

1. Supply lists are given at time of registration. The cost of supplies, unless so noted, are not included in the class fee. Sewing supplies are not optional.

The instructors spend much time planning the classes for your enjoyment and part of this includes using the proper equipment.

2. Please purchase your supplies before class. We appreciate your business and we offer a discount of 10% for class supplies. Just show us your class receipt.
3. We need a minimum of 5 to hold a class. You may want to check with us before you purchase your supplies to be sure the class is a go. We don't want you to purchase supplies for a small class that may be cancelled.

Parking:

1. Our parking lot holds 20-25 automobiles. After our lot is full you can use the street parking or if surrounding business's are closed you can use their parking lots.
2. On Saturday mornings, our employees will be glad to carry your sewing machine when you pull up to the front door. Then you can park your car. We close at 1pm, so there is no one here to carry machines. We suggest you invest in a wheeled carrying bag or a set of luggage wheels.

Other Information:

1. If a class is full you may have your name placed on a waiting list, in case a student cancels.
2. No make ups on sewing classes. If you miss a class or need additional help, you can make arrangements with the class instructor at her professional fee.
3. Please be considerate of others. Do not bring children to class, wear heavy perfume or use cell phones during class. Please be on time for class or better yet, come 15 minutes early to set up your sewing space. Classes begin promptly at the scheduled time. If you are unable to make the class session, please call so we will know not to expect you.
4. We need 5 or more students to hold class. It is important to register early.
5. We usually limit our classes to 15 students (unless a club meeting). It is important to register early. A waiting list is started once a class has reached its maximum.
6. The use of cell phones is disruptive to other paying students and instructors. Please wait until class breaks or step outside for calls.
7. Please mark your calendar with your classes. We do not make reminder calls. We will contact you if a class is cancelled or changed.
8. If the weather is ice or snow, we will contact you as to class changes. You can also call or e-mail us.
9. If a class is cancelled due to uncontrollable circumstances such as weather or emergencies, we will contact you as to the schedule for the make up class.

Our Commitment to our Instructors...

We give our instructors one week notice whether their class is "a go". This gives them time to make their final preparation for a quality class. This is why we must make a decision as to whether to cancel a class or not within one week. If a student calls after that date to cancel, we cannot give a refund or credit for class or move the money paid to another class. The commitment of students and payment has been made to the instructor. And if a student doesn't show up, we cannot give a refund or credit. Please mark your calendars when you register for classes.

Sewing Class Etiquette:

We have polled a group of sewing students and asked how could we improve our education department and this is what was suggested:

1. If you sign up, then show up! This means: if you register for a class and don't attend, or cancel late, it can cause the other students and teachers to suffer in lost attendance and fees, especially in Guide classes.
2. Come to class prepared and in a timely fashion, to set up your sewing area.
3. Cell phones are not appropriate during class. Please step away from class area for personal calls.
4. While we all love children, sewing class is not the place for them unless they are taking a children's class.
5. Be courteous and be aware of heavy perfume.
6. The main idea to remember is the "Golden Rule". Be courteous to your fellow teachers and students.
